What is Restylane?

Holding back the years...

Line fillers are used to treat areas of fine lines, wrinkles, deeper folds or to plump up the lips or the border of the lips.

- Vermilion Border (Paris lip) - The upper edge of the lip
- Naso-labial Lines - Nose to mouth lines/folds
- Glabellar Lines - Frown Lines
- Marionette Lines - From the corners of the mouth down to the chin
- Peri-oral Lines - Around the mouth (smokers lines)

Restylane is an exciting injection procedure that can get rid of wrinkles and enhances areas of your face immediately. Some of those areas include the lips, superficial lines around the mouth, forehead lines, and smile lines.

Non-animal hyaluronic acid is manufactured by a unique method in the Q-Med Laboratories in Sweden. The treatment is performed by injecting Restylane into the skin or lip, and because no pre-test is needed it takes less than 30 minutes. Hyaluronic acid occurs naturally in the body and therefore it also dissolves naturally with time.

Hyaluronic acid is present in all living organisms. In your skin it creates volume, resulting in a healthy and vital appearance. Restylane contains hyaluronic acid in the form of a crystal-clear gel injected into the skin to lift the lip, wrinkle or fold. Once in the skin, Restylane works together with the body's own hyaluronic acid and joins forces to create volume.

In contrast to other biodegradable implants, Restylane is not extracted from animals. This means no risk of allergic reactions. Therefore, Restylane is perfectly safe to use instantly without pre-testing.
